CDC GUIDELINES

SOCIAL DISTANCING

You and your family must follow the social distancing guidelines recommended by the CDC and government. This includes keeping at least 6ft between yourself and someone outside of your household. CDC recommendations are to wear cloth face coverings, but this is not required. Please have no indoor gatherings larger than 10 people, and maintain social distance. Talk to your children (and teenagers) about the importance of social distancing.

CHECKING IN:

Prior to your arrival, you will receive instructions for our Express Check In option. In order to minimize contact, we recommend using this option. The office is still available for physical check in, and must be utilized if you plan on paying cash.

Due to increased sanitation measures, our check in time is now guaranteed after 3pm.

GATE ENTRANCE

Please use our keypad to enter the park. We would recommend using gloves or sanitizing your hands after use.

POOL

The pool will be open beginning June 8th. Pool chairs have been distanced to 6' apart, and will be sanitized daily. Pool Occupancy is reduced by 50%. A hand sanitizing station is available at the pool entrance. Please practice social distancing and good hygiene at all times.

OUTDOOR RECREATION

At this time, the following amenities are open: Playground, Gaga Ball, Volleyball, Basketball, Cornhole, & Ping Pong. Hand sanitizing stations are available at the entrance of the playground; we kindly ask all guests to make frequent use of this. The playground will be sanitized daily.

Until further notice, recreation equipment will not be available for loan, and guests are asked to bring their own. Please practice social distancing and good hygiene at all times.

FACILITIES

The bathrooms and showers are available with the exception of the showers in the north bathhouse and the bathroom in the store. Due to increased cleaning measures, periodic closures of the bathrooms and showers will occur.

The laundry is open. A hand sanitizing station is available at the door. Machines will be sanitized daily.

VISITORS

Please pre-register any daytime or overnight guests. State law limits occupancy to a maximum of 8 persons per site (4 adults and 4 children ages 18 and under).

PETS

Keep pets leashed and at a safe distance of 6ft from other campers at all times. Pet stations are available in the back of the park only.

SLRC STORE

Our physical location is open. Under current Executive Orders, face masks are recommended in the store. Our lobby has been converted to a check out station; our beverage area has been moved here as well. Slushies, cappuccino and coffee are still available, but must be ordered and will be prepared by a Team Member.

We are also offering delivery and pick up options; visit shop.silverlakerc.com for more information. Our lobby has been converted to serve as pick-up and delivery options for you as well.

The bathroom in the store has been converted for Team Members only.

FAILURE TO COMPLY

If you don't respect these guidelines, you will be asked to leave until the guidelines are lifted. No refunds or discounts will be given for any reason to those who don't comply with these guidelines.

We are trusting that you will be respectful of these guidelines and use common sense. We are hopeful our camping community can set an example to all do our part to keep us safe during this pandemic. We also ask that you do not over police each other during this time and use good judgement on what to report to management.
